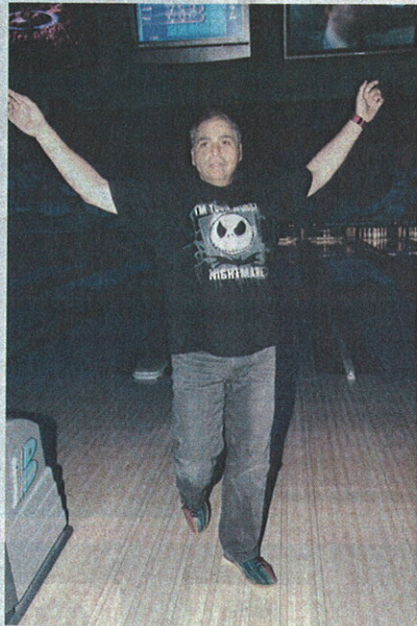




Royal LePage Burloak Real Estate Services BOWLING EVENT Raising Money For Local Shelters
